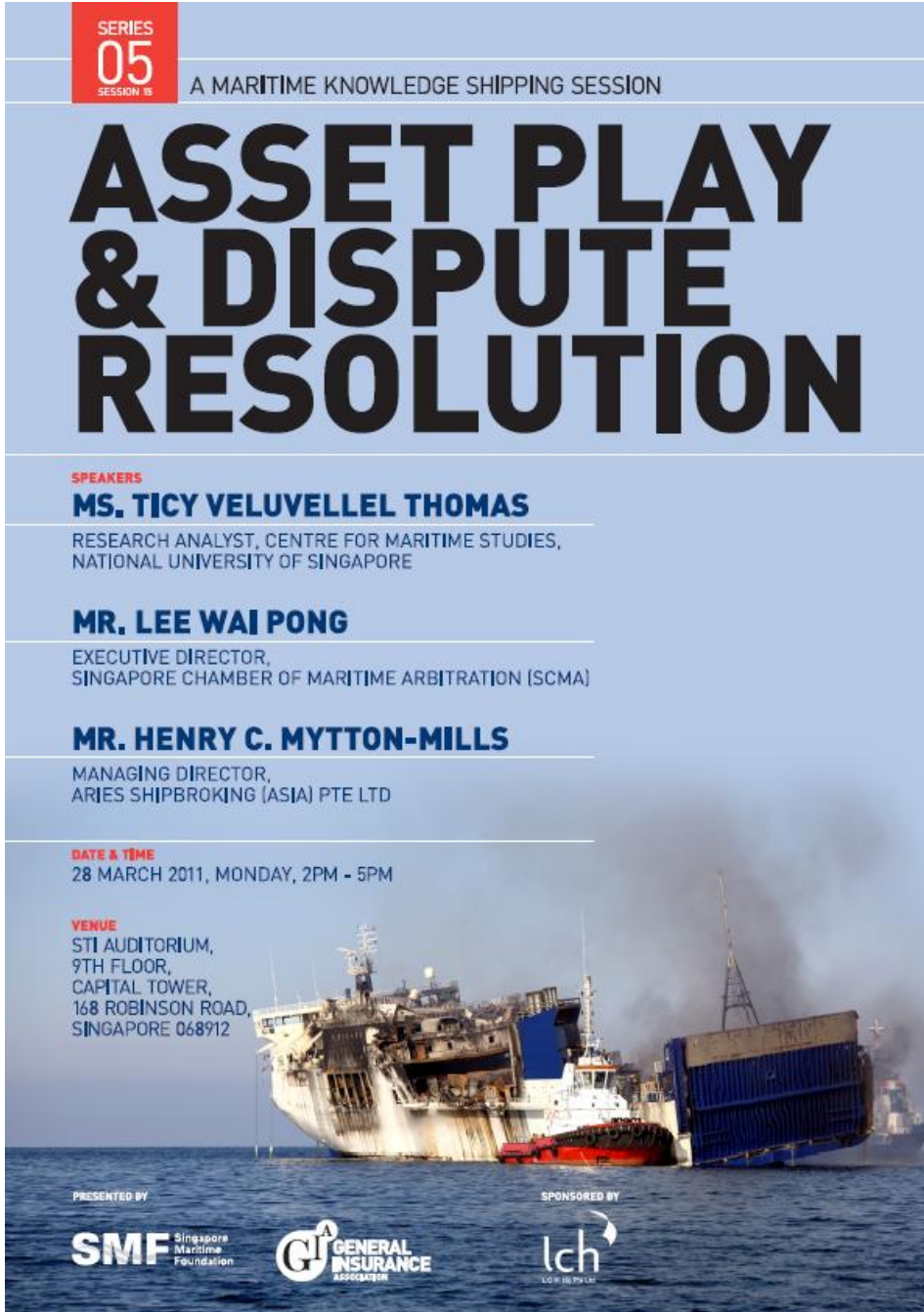

## SYNOPSIS & SPEAKER PROFILE



**Ms. Ticy Veluvellel Thomas**  
Research Analyst, Centre for Maritime Studies, National University of Singapore

### **Presentation Topic: Understanding Ship Sale & Purchase & Its Complexities**

The first speaker, Ms Ticy Veluvellel Thomas, Research Analyst, Centre for Maritime Studies, National University of Singapore will share an overview of the common practices in

the ship asset market such as what do people look out for when they purchase and sell vessels, and the details involved in the sale & purchase process.

From the checklist of the various key determinants that would affect the decision-making process of the ship buyers and sellers, Ticy will explain some of these issues in-depth and give participants a better understanding of how the complex ship sale & purchase process is documented from a legal perspective. She will also share some of the key highlights of the newly launched Singapore Ship Sale Form (SSF) and use real-life case studies to give participants a better understanding of the workings of a ship sale transaction and the potential for costly disputes.

**Presenter: Ticy Veluvellet Thomas**  
**Research Analyst, Centre for Maritime Studies, National University of Singapore**

Ms Ticy V. Thomas graduated from the University of Kerala, India with a Bachelor of Law degree (First Class) in 2002. She was admitted to the Bar Council of India in the same year. In 2003, she went on to pursue her post-graduate research degree in Public International Law at the Centre for International Legal Studies, School of International Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, India and specialised in International Law of the Sea. She graduated with a Masters of Philosophy – International Law in 2005.

Ticy is currently based in Singapore as a research analyst at the Centre for Maritime Studies, National University of Singapore (November 2007 to present). She has undertaken the consultancy project of the Singapore Ship Sale Form and has been working closely with the Singapore Maritime Foundation and the key maritime stakeholders to bring the form to fruition. She has also conducted independent research on contemporary subjects of international and national law and published research papers.

Prior to this, she worked as the Legal Associate of the National Maritime Foundation, New Delhi and worked with the officers in the Indian Navy on issues pertaining to legal documentation and contracts. As a student, she had also worked with the International Tribunal for Law of the Sea, Germany as a legal intern and served the Regional Delegation of the ICRC in South Asia, India as a project intern. She has also been invited to present papers in national and international conferences. She is also a member of the Asian Society of International Law and Indian Society of International Law.

**Presentation Topic: Arbitration – an overview of its process and application to the maritime community. Introduction into workings of SCMA**



The second speaker, Mr Lee Wai Pong, Executive Director of SCMA will take the audience through basic models of dispute resolution before elaborating on the actual arbitration process. He will then illustrate how it is uniquely applied order to respond to the needs, cultures and customs of the maritime industry and what distinguishes maritime arbitration from main stream arbitration. He will also explore in detail with the audience, how Singapore with its unique blend of culture, skilled population and infrastructure positions itself as a natural centre for dispute resolution for the Asia Pacific.

Wai Pong will finally take the audience through the arbitration facilities available in Singapore and how SCMA intends to extend its outreach to the less obvious sectors of the maritime community and how it plans to strengthen its role as the “go-to” place for contracting parties seeking a fair and just resolution to their contractual disputes.
